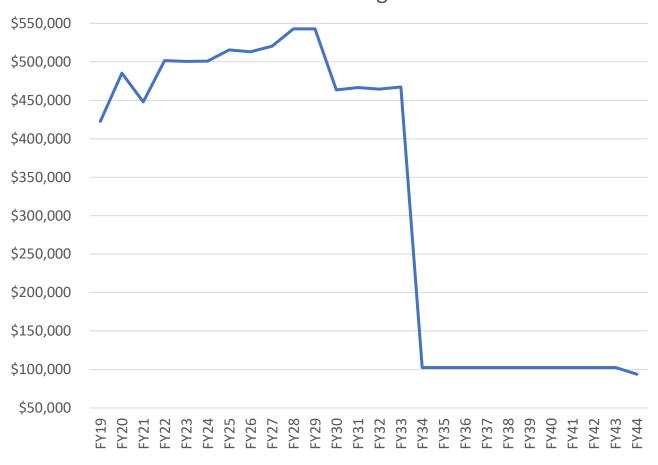


## **Debt Obligation**
